SUPPORTING CRITERIA.

The proposed project will be assessed against the below criteria for each relevant priority area which has been indicated in the application form.

It is not required to meet all outcomes detailed below but must evidence at least against one criteria to be eligible for funding.

SUSTAINING & GROWING THE LOCAL ECONOMY

The proposed project must bring direct or indirect local economic benefit.

- Increased local employment and skills – funding will result in improving employability for the community or equip members with new skills
- Micro-business support – funding will help local entrepreneurs to cover initial start up costs or expand their services

WELLBEING

The proposed project must improve the quality of life for its beneficiaries.

- Community Fitness – grant funding will help improve the physical wellbeing of the community through exercise classes, equipment or recreational activity which encourages healthier lifestyles

- Mental Health Support – funding will lead to improved mental health outcomes by providing support service or network for community members
- Health awareness – funding will help raise awareness about health issues and preventative care
- Green spaces – the funding will increase the local community's engagement with, or access to, nature and green spaces

INCLUSIVITY

The Borough of Barnet aims to be one which is inclusive where everyone's hopes and aspirations can be made real. The project must look to support this.

- Cultural events and festivals – funding will support small-scale events that celebrate diversity within the community
- Accessibility and education – Funding will be used to make spaces, services and opportunities more accessible for all
- Youth and Elderly engagement – funding may support initiatives which bring together different age groups or support a typically marginalised group to better engage with the community
